OBITUARY.

MRS. ELIZA AVERY.

The death took place this morning of Mrs. Eliza Avery, widow of the late Mr. Thomas Avery, at her residence, Avenue Road, New Plymouth, at the age of 81 years.

Mrs. Avery, who was a native of London, came to New Zealand in the year 1877, and was married to Mr. Avery on Christmas Day of that year. She spent the whole of her life in New Zealand at New Plymouth, and although she took little part in public organisations, she was nevertheless widely known and highly esteemed among a large circle of friends, whose sympathy will be extended to the members of her family in the bereavement they have suffered. Mr. Avery died on October 15, 1926. One thing by which Mrs. Avery will be gratefully remembered by the public, and by those interested in the Scout movement particularly, was the gift of a section of land at Avenue Road as a reserve for the use of Scouts. Mrs. Avery is survived by a family of one daughter and four sons, namely, Miss G. E. Avery, and Messrs. T. M., J. E. and A. H. (of New Plymouth) and F. S. Avery (of Auckland). The funeral is to be a private one.
