The photograph, which appeared in the Taranaki Daily News in August 1992, showed a group of houses being moved off a site next to the Plymouth International Hotel – known at that time as the Plymouth Sun – to make way for construction of a 3 Guys supermarket. It was duly built, and was known most recently as a Countdown, and has now closed.

When this photograph was published, demolition work had also started further along Leach St-Courtenay St to make way for a New World supermarket. That supermarket is still in operation and has just been enlarged.
