During the 1914-18 war years, prices of goods rose dramatically. Towards the end of the period, CC Ward cabled his suppliers in London telling them to cancel all

connections. They replied. "Your cable received, Please repeat."

CC's reasons for the puzzling cable became obvious with the cessation of hostillowers of the puzzling cable became obvious with the cessation of hostillowing the post-war economies. Wholesal-ers however were caught with high-priced stocks and many were forced to close.

The far-sighted New Plymouth man travelled throughout the central Northy sales and shipping the goods to his home store.


