
SAVE THE ARCADIA HOTEL BUILDING

The decision to demolish this building was made in a public excluded council meeting, and the demolition contract awarded immediately. Demolition work has already started.

Why can't the building be left until a valid use for the site is agreed upon, or perhaps incorporate the building into the new Museum development. It is after all part of New Plymouth's history.

This building has a place in our city's urban redevelopment.
